

<p>Care Coordination</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Schedule patient's appointments using discretion and prioritizing most important referrals • Exhibit knowledge of care transitions needs and primary care role • Demonstrate knowledge of specialist types and needs for information • Develop understanding of care coordination needs
<p>Patient Centered Care</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate understanding of key concepts • Exhibit patient centered care in choice of care options
<p>Chronic Disease Care</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show understanding between acute and chronic disease • Understanding of basic evidence based guidelines and use within the practice team • Demonstrates knowledge of common chronic diseases • Exhibit primary care and specialist role in managing chronic disease care
<p>Infection Control</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate application of key infection control technique to prevent spread of disease • Understanding of infection • Show ability for the front office role to understand infection control in patient care
<p>Hypertension</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate knowledge of signs/symptoms of hypertension • Recognize risk factors of hypertension • Understand anatomy and disease process related to hypertension • Recognize what care team actions could be taken to improve health and prevent hypertension
<p>Diabetes Care</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognize signs/ symptoms of diabetes • Understand anatomy & disease process • Recognize risk factors of diabetes • Recognize what care team actions could be taken to improve health and prevent diabetes
